None of the toxic elements, Cadmium, Hexavalent Chromium, Lead, or Mercury are used as raw materials or deliberately added in the manufacturing process of Anchor Packaging's containers and film products. With this in mind, we feel our products are free from the above-mentioned toxic elements. Any incidental amount would be expected to be less than 100 parts per million (ppm).

This specification compliance is for the finished product, provided it is unmodified and used in accordance with recommended applications by the consumer. Anchor Packaging is a processor of plastic containers and film products and induces no changes that would affect compliance with CONEG regulations. Anchor relies on good faith with its suppliers and guarantees compliance of the products as described above up to the time the products are shipped. Thereafter, it is the responsibility of the customer to ensure that all applicable conditions and specifications outlined under the above-mentioned regulatory categories are maintained.
