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Subject: FDA Compliance and Consumer Reuse of Polypropylene Products

This letter is in response to your request for information regarding FDA compliance of Anchor Packaging's Polypropylene-based Food Packaging. The polypropylene, as manufactured, complies with Food and Drug Administration, Title 21, Code of Federal Regulations 177.1520.

Additionally, each ingredient of the colorant used to manufacture these products complies with the following sections of Title 21, Code of Federal Regulations:

177.1350

178.329

177.1620

178.2010

181.28

These sections represent the official sanction of these ingredients by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for use in food contact applications, such as packaging.

The overall migration limit of max. 10-mg/dm2 contact surface or 60 mg/kg food must be met by the final article coming into contact with foodstuffs. Polypropylene products can withstand temperatures of up to 230° F under heat lamps, warming units/tunnels, or microwaves.

The nature of Polypropylene creates rigid containers and lids that are suitable for reuse by the consumer.

Anchor Packaging is a processor of polypropylene and colorant materials and induces no changes that would affect compliance with the indicated regulations.

Anchor relies on good faith with its suppliers and guarantees compliance of the products as described above up to the time the products are shipped. Thereafter, it is the customer's responsibility to ensure that all applicable conditions and specifications outlined under the above-mentioned regulatory categories are maintained.
